This is to acknowledge receipt of your electronic mail (email).

For the proper, efficient, and timely processing of your email correspondence, kindly note the following:

- 1. Only submissions of Certifications on the Undertaking of Early Procurement Activities (EPA) are accepted in this email account.
- 2. The submission of certification is required by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) on the Harmonization of National Government Performance Monitoring, Information and Reporting System through Memorandum Circular Nos. 2021-1¹ and 2021-2,² wherein Procuring Entities (PEs)³ that would like to be eligible for the grant of the Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) are required to successfully undertake Early Procurement Activities (EPA) for at least fifty percent (50%) of the total value of Eligible Procurement Projects (EPPs)⁴ included in its Indicative Annual Procurement Plan⁵ consistent with the National Expenditure Program.
- PEs are considered compliant with the EPA requirement for the grant of PBB based on the following considerations:
 - 3.1. Submission of the applicable EPA Certification under Oath using the applicable prescribed template⁶ on or before 31st of January of the fiscal year;
 - 3.2. The Certification submitted shows that the PE has either <u>successfully undertaken EPA</u> for at least fifty percent (50%) of the total amount of EPPs or the PE is <u>not covered</u> by the EPA requirement (i.e., procurement projects do not receive budgetary support from the National Government or are to be undertaken through the exempted modalities); and
 - 3.3. The Certification is signed by the Head of the Procuring Entity.
