PENRO Cotabato Re-echoes Roll-out Workshop on the Enhanced Forestry Information System (eFIS)

Kidapawan City – In order to acquire the knowledge, skills and appreciation of CENR Offices under PENRO Cotabato, Information System Analyst II Armando C. Victoria facilitated the conduct of re-echo on the Roll Out Enhanced FIS that enable the participants to become more familiar the innovations in the utilization (and sharing) of information through web-based online information system.



Above photo, Mr. Victoria emphasized the filling up of MDE form (Module) as an initial step in updating the records of tenurial instrument holders in the province. He explained the new clustering of each module that includes POFIS (People Oriented Forest Information System) which will focus more on community profiles. He also discussed the new interface of the system as it was easily retrievable and easy to generate any form of the reports as required by any official of the DENR. He narrated the implications of online encoding and decoding of information without any hassle on the part of the query.

The single day activity held at CENRO Matalam Conference room was attended by FIS Focal person of CENRO Midsayap, Jonah Mae De Vera and Forester Lita C. This is to provide the public easy to access to the information when transacting the government which is in support to the good governance policy of the government.
